

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS 2023 YEAR 7 CAMP

Where is the camp?

Camp Adair, Hunua Ranges

When is camp?

Term 1 Week 9

GREEN CAMP Room's 11, 12, 13, 14, 15,16, 17, 18: Monday 27th March - Wednesday 29th March

BLUE CAMP Room's 1, 8, 9, 10, 26, 27, 28 Wednesday 29th March - Friday 31st March

What is the cost of this year's camp?

\$315.00 incl GST which covers accommodation, instructors, meals, activity fees and transport.

How many parents can attend camp?

In order for the camp to proceed we are required to have 20 parent helpers for the duration of the camp. Ideally we make up the numbers with parents who can stay for the 3 days of their child's camp to provide consistency. If there are not enough parents who can stay for the duration, we will then invite parents who have indicated that they are available on various days.

Do the parent helpers who are attending camp pay?

What are the sleeping arrangements?

Each cabin can hold between 10 - 14 students.

There are no adults in student cabins, instead adults will share with other parents who are staying to help.

How will the students be organised?

Generally students are put into activity groups by their teachers of between 10 - 12 children. This is an opportunity for our students to work with a variety of other students from their class. This of course will be dependent on final numbers attending the camp.

What time do the students need to be at school on the day of their camp?

Wwe would ask all students travelling to camp to arrive at school before 8.30am. Bags are to be taken to the hall and then students are asked to go to class for roll call. From there, the teachers will organise the bus loadings.

What time do the students return from camp?

The buses leave Camp Adair at 1.15pm and arrive at school between 2.15pm and 2.30pm. Parents are asked to collect students from the hall.

What happens if my child becomes sick?

Students who become unwell will be required to be collected from camp. The student will be isolated until a family member arrives. Children who become unwell must be collected on the day of notification as it is not possible to have an isolated student sleep alone.

What if we have paid for our child but they cannot attend due to illness?

You will receive a refund of payment that has been made for Camp.

What if we would like our child to go to camp but cannot make the payment deadline?

Can we come out and visit our children at camp?

Camp Adair asks that only parents who are helping on the activities be on camp grounds.

What will happen to the students who do not go to camp?

Students not attending camp will be able to come to school and take part in a range of run activities that our remaining teachers will organise.

How do the students get to camp?

Students will be transported by bus. Parents who are staying for the duration of the camp are welcome to travel on the bus, or you are able to make your own way out to Camp Adair.
